Fire Division Committee Meetings

To discuss various affairs of the Fire Division, a total of ten Divisional Committee Meetings were held from July 2024 to April 2025.

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Courses

With the lead of Ir Kennis Wan, we have successfully organized a series of CPD courses to cover six domains for fire safety engineering including (1) fire science; (2) active fire protection measures; (3) passive fire protection measures; (4) human psychology and physiology; (5) law, regulations, and standards; and (6) fire risk management.

This year, CPD training course which consists of six lectures has been successfully held between 17th February and 31st March 2025 with total attendance of more than 500 persons. In addition, all these lectures were delivered by 14 distinguished professionals of the industry. In particular, it is also our honour to have great support from the Fire Services Department and Buildings Department for having their representatives in the lectures and shared with us the latest fire safety requirements on respective aspects, including the *Fire Safety Requirements for Data Centres and Battery Rooms* and the recent updates & interpretation on *Code of Practice for Fire Safety in Buildings 2011*.



Urban Renewal Authority (URA) – Home Safety Improvement Community Program

The Fire Division was invited by the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) to participate in the launching ceremony for the Home Safety Improvement Community Programme (HSICP) on 25th September 2024 and gave a brief sharing about home fire safety in the event. The HSICP in partnership with community organisations in Kowloon City, Central and Western District, Kwun Tong, Sham Shui Po, and Yau Tsim Mong to provide home safety solutions with essential safety and fire protection facilities for free to the needy elderly and underprivileged families, including those living in sub-divided units and ethnic minorities.

Furthermore, in order to enhance Home and Fire Safety for Underprivileged Families in old districts, the Fire Division had participated in the HSICP by providing fire safety advice for developing customised solutions for beneficiary families to improve home safety, offering guidance on increasing safety awareness and providing Volunteer Briefing Sessions.



Offer Professional Views to the Government Departments for Fire Safety Aspects

Representatives of the Fire Division had attended various meetings organizing by Government Department and offered our views on different topics:

- Legislative Council meeting with deputations regarding the **Fire Safety (Buildings)(Amendment) Bill 2024** on 21st September 2024 in the LegCo Complex
- Fire Services Department regarding “**Establishment of One-stop Coordination Office for New Fire Protection Facilities Acceptance of Fire Services Department (FSD)**” on 29th October 2024, and 21st November 2024
- Housing Bureau’s meeting regarding consultation on the “**Proposed Regulatory Regime on Basic Housing Units (BHU)**” on 29th November 2024 and “**Cost Saving in Construction**” on 7th February 2025

Registered Fire Engineer Scheme

The Fire Division had coordinated with the FSD for arranging webinar session regarding “*Introduction of the Registered Fire Engineer Scheme*” on 19th March 2025 to update our members about registration requirements, duties of RFE and regulatory mechanism in order to keep our members posted on the latest development of this Scheme.

Seminar Session to Property Management Services Authority (PMSA)

The Fire Division had participated in the licensing regime by providing a seminar of “Fire Risk Management Plan” to the Tier-1 class of property management practitioner as well as joining the webinar on Property Management Industry Licensing Regime and Regulatory Measures. The PMSA is the statutory body established under the Property Management Services Ordinance (Cap. 626) and aims to encourage and assist property management (PM) companies and PM practitioners (PMP) in striving for enhancement in professionalism and quality.



17th HKIE Fire Division Annual Dinner

The Annual Dinner was successfully held on 27th March 2025 at the Crowne Plaza Hong Kong Kowloon East. A keynote speech was delivered by the Principal Guest of Honour Ir CHOW Hau-keung, Vincent, JP, Deputy Director/Trading Service of EMSD, HKSAR Government.

Prominent guests and professionals joined this Annual Dinner and told the good stories of fire engineers. All the participants were happy and experienced pleasure in this particular circumstance.



Strengthen Technical Exchange, Experience Sharing and Deepen Knowledge of Fire Safety among Members

In this session, Fire Division had actively organized/participated multiple technical visits and occasions for the members as follows:

1. “Fire Asia 2024” – International Conference

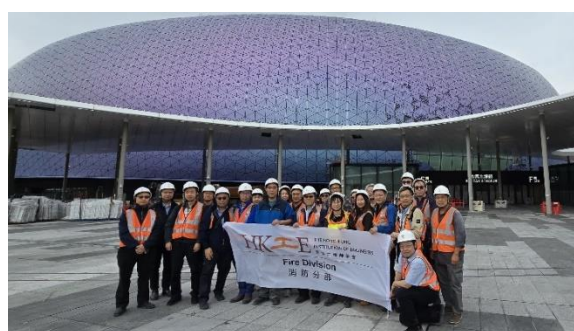
Fire Division co-organized this triennial event from 10th to 12th July 2024. “Fire Asia 2024” addressed a range of topics, including performance-based design, cutting-edge technology in safety engineering, and emergency response management. Distinguished speakers from abroad, the Greater Bay Area, and local experts shared their valuable insights during the three-day conference.



2. **Technical visit to Galaxy Macau** on 2nd November 2024. During the tour, representatives from Galaxy and AECOM guided our members through Galaxy Phase 1, 2 & 3 which have adopted the International Building Code (IBC) for the fire and life safety design.



3. **Technical visit to Kai Tak Sport Park** on 19th November 2024. During the tour, the fire engineering design for the Kai Tak Sports Park, including the main stadium, was introduced to members.



4. **Technical visit to the Tseung Kwan O Desalination Plant** to be held on 26th April 2025. During the tour, the design of Fire Services Installations (FSI) would be introduced to members.

Annual Technical Delegation 2025 to Chengdu and Chongqing (成都及重慶)

The Fire Division will send a delegation to Chengdu and Chongqing from 16th to 20th May 2025 to discover recent developments and applications in fire safety across Mainland China. The visit aims to enrich participants' knowledge of state-of-the-art fire engineering technology, fire safety, and firefighting operations. It will also provide valuable networking opportunities with fire professionals in Chengdu and Chongqing. Furthermore, the delegation will be visiting the Sichuan Fire Research Institute, where delegation can explore cutting-edge research and advancements in fire safety and emergency management; the newly developed Chengdu Tianfu International Airport, a marvel of modern aviation that stands as a testament to Mainland China's rapid infrastructural development; and explore Raffles City Chongqing, an architectural wonder that seamlessly blends retail, residential, and commercial spaces, offering breathtaking views of the city.

16th HKIE Fire Division Annual Symposium 2025

The Annual Symposium 2025 of Fire Division will be conducted on 13th May 2025 at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre. The main theme of the Symposium is "Global Innovations in Fire Safety: Collaborating for Excellence". This year, we are honored to have Ms. Lillian CHEONG Man Lei, JP, Under Secretary for Innovation, Technology and Industry Development to be the Principal Guest of Honour. Prominent speakers from two overseas/mainland professional/scholars and six local professional/scholars have been invited to present interesting technical papers, share their valuable experiences and insights with local experts in the Symposium.

Promotion to Youngsters

Fire Division nominated two committee members, Ir Sunny WONG and Ir Angus S P WONG to follow up the action items suggested by the Task Force under PSC on promoting engineering education to secondary school students in Hong Kong. In addition, YMC introduced a scheme, namely “Young or Ready Series”, which was set to help young members to decide and equip themselves to the route of a professional engineer in different disciplines. YMC would like to collaborate with FE Division for promoting the scheme.
